Newark Academy will be taking part in this year's Christmas Jumper Day for Save the Children on Friday 16<sup>th</sup> December.

Christmas Jumper Day raises money to support Save the Children's work with the world's poorest children. From school books and classrooms, to mosquito nets and life-saving vaccines, our festive fundraising will help the children who need it most.

For example, a class of 25 students taking part would raise enough to vaccinate two children against deadly diseases in Sierra Leone – one of the world's toughest places to grow up.

All pupils and teachers are invited to wear a Christmas jumper on Friday 16<sup>th</sup> December and make a £1 donation to help support Save the Children's vital work. The Christmas jumper must be worn as an accessory to usual school uniform – although blazers do not have to be worn.
