'Success for All' evening - Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> March 5pm-7pm.

As we enter this crucial phase of preparation for the final GCSE exams I would like to invite Pupils and Parents / Carers to our Year 11 'Success for All' evening.

The aim of the evening is for Parents and Pupils to gain an insight into the skills and techniques needed to support themselves through the revision period. It will be a fantastic opportunity to learn about techniques such as mind mapping and using prompt cards.

In addition, the core departments of English, Mathematics and Science will be running a presentation about revising in their subject.
