





This year we will be staying in the Davy Crockett Ranch just a short bus ride from the Disney Parks. The accommodation is small cabins that include a kitchenette, bathroom and two bedrooms. The accommodation will house 4 or 5 students, these will be allocated closer to the departure date.



# Full Kit list

**All items must be named and all bags must have name tags on**

## **A large bag / suitcase**

All students must have Newark Academy kit for matches and coaching academies

- Netball/football kit for 3 days – bag to take to Netball/football
  - 1 / 2 pairs trainers or football boots
  - Netball kit – skorts (black) / shorts - Black (for under dresses) / school PE polo shirt x 2
  - Football Kit – NA football kit / black shorts & NA polo shirt x2
  - towels x2
  - Tracksuit bottoms – preferably the NA green piped tracksuit bottoms
  - Hoody (Tour hoody and school hoody)
  - 2x Water bottles (large bottles)
- Jeans / trousers min x2
- Tops / jumpers – enough for the 3 evenings at Disney
- Smart clothes & shoes for the Awards and evening dinner
- Sensible shoes for Disneyland
- Coat / Jacket
- Enough underwear for the 5 days – don't forget changing from sports kit to normal wear!
- Nightwear
- Toiletries
- Towels (for showers and your kit bag)
- Swimming Kit (optional)
- Suncream/hat/water proof coat
- 2 x purse / wallet
- Any extra snacks / drinks you may wish to bring – please ensure these are bagged sensibly and they are non-perishable
- You may wish to bring an autograph book as you may meet some England Netball players and maybe a Disney character or two!!
- You will also need a packed lunch box/bag for packed lunches throughout the week.

## Wednesday

A bag that you will need to carry on the coach with you;

- Food/Drink for the day - Breakfast/Lunch/Tea – Make sure you have plenty as service stations are expensive and there will be little opportunity to buy food/drinks
- Waterproof
- Money – Sterling and Euros
- Electronic items may be brought but these are the sole responsibility of the student and earphones must be worn. Please ensure these items are covered by your own insurance.

## Jewellery

Please be advised that ALL jewellery must be removed before playing Netball/football. This is an England Netball rule and the England Netball coaches will not allow you to play if you are wearing any. Therefore, we are recommending that you do not bring any jewellery on tour. A wrist watch will be acceptable, but must be removed before playing. All items are the students' responsibility and should be covered on your own insurance.

## Nails (Netball)

England netball rules are that nails must be cut short or the player cannot play in any training or match. Please ensure your daughters nails are cut short – no false / gel / or long nails.

## Money

You will need Sterling and Euros.

You may bring some money with you for food/drinks throughout the five days as stated above. The amount is up to you and you will be fully responsible for it.

You may also bring some money with you to purchase items from Disney Land. We suggest that you go online to have a quick look at prices before we travel.

**The money that you bring with you needs to be in a secure purse/wallet.**

All money that you bring will be your responsibility. Please be sensible about the amount that you bring.
