



Dear Parent / Guardian,

We are pleased to announce that we are now in a position to provide students with additional opportunities to further enrich their curriculum outside of the classroom with external providers starting week commencing 2nd November – see timetable for details.

To ensure that all of our activities are accessible to ALL, we are continuing to keep all of our enrichment clubs free of charge.

If students wish to partake in Sports Enrichment either at lunch time or after school, we ask that they attend school in their PE kit on the days these clubs are taking place as changing facilities will remain closed until further notice.

If you have already given consent for other staff led activities last term you do not need to do this again for those particular activities, it's only for new clubs that your son/daughter wishes to attend.

Please be aware that some after school enrichment clubs have a maximum student capacity that is required by health and safety. Therefore, you will be contacted by the school ASAP if we have been unable to register your child for any enrichment club you have requested. Any student in this situation will be placed on a waiting list and you will be contacted again once a place becomes available.

Please also ensure that you are only signing up for the activities offered to your son's / daughter's year group; this is stated for each activity.


